As the world's largest mid-day meal provider, for the last 22 years, TAPF has been serving hot meals to over 2 million children, daily in India. Here in the UK, we serve children across London and Greater London. Our food service multiplies during school holidays, serving children eligible for free school meal vouchers, among several others. Our food is vegetarian, nutritious and kind on the planet. It travels in sustainable and insulated steel containers.

Over 10,000 hot meals dressed with nutrition, are going out over the Easter school holidays, freshly prepared for children of low-income families at council run holiday clubs and community centres. We are serving at over 60 locations including the heart of London, via the City of London authorities.

New Kitchens in India

In the last couple of months we have inaugurated three new kitchens taking the total number of our kitchens in India to 66.

64 out of 66 kitchens are automated fully centralized facilities that cook can anywhere between 3k to 200k meals per cycle, utilizing gravity flow mechanisms to human minimize handling of food for enhanced safety and quality.



At the recently held Sigma Conference in the Dominican Republic, Sigma helped raise funds to support atleast 50,000 hot meals in the UK.




STORY OF TRANSFORMATION

Nasir Baig was determined to become a Chartered Accountant. From a low-income household, he is the eldest of three brothers. His father works at a factory producing incense sticks, while his mother is a homemaker.

A long-time beneficiary of the Mid-Day Meal Programme, Nasir was inspired by his school faculty and Akshaya Patra to pursue his dream. He received a scholarship under the Foundation's BEYOND MEALS Programme to pursue his CA course.

In early 2022, he passed his examinations and wishes to go on to work in the manufacturing or fast-moving consumer goods industries, with the goal of eventually starting his own firm.
